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The *Post School Options for Young People with Disabilities- Gap Needs Analysis* project seeks to assist in the development of meaningful post school work and activity options for young people with disabilities who have high needs. The project aims to identify potential long-term solutions by examining local opportunities as well as best practice examples around Australia.

As part of the consultation process a series of focus groups is being organised. The focus group meetings will inform the project and assist to identify the major themes for development.

Initially three focus group meetings for parents and carers have been arranged but more will be organised if it is felt necessary. The number of participants in each meeting will be limited to ten in order to enable effective interaction.
